Also include:

- 1. \$25.00 nonrefundable application fee payable to "UrbanPromise Wilmington"
- 2. Copy of child's birth certificate
- 3. Copy of most recent income tax return (if you wish to be considered for reduced tuition)

We also require that the following information be submitted at least one month prior to the start of the school year:

- 1. Current record of medical inoculations and completed physical examination form
- 2. Emergency treatment form
- 3. Transportation form
